Why is it important to analyze PAYS data?

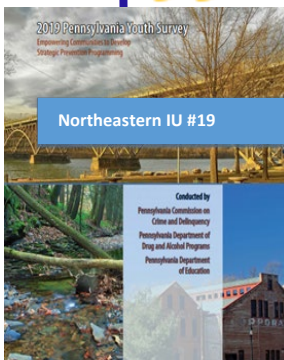


Analyzing PAYS data will help you to:
