## -All program costs will need to be justified by the implementation plan and the numbers served.

Additional materials information:

- Workbooks may be used as a "classroom set"-i.e., students would not write in them. This would significantly reduce ongoing costs.
- Free supplemental materials may be downloaded from the developer's website to support certain lessons.
- Each classroom will need a chalkboard and/or Power Point or overhead capacity.
- Duplicating costs for pre/post measures and miscellaneous materials should be included and will vary by site.
- The ideal Project TND budget will address costs related to administration of pre/post measures and data entry.
- The video for Session 12, "Drugs and Life's Dreams" (\$25.00) is optional and is not recommended.
- Training Consultants to conduct a two (2) day, on-site training prior to implementation, including travel costs.
- Keep in mind that costs for training travel could include airfare, airport parking, rental car, and per diem (hotel, meals). This total may vary, depending on where the trainer and training site is located.
- Due to attrition of teachers, you may need to budget for a Year 2 on-site training for new staff implementing the program.

- Option A: Training for up to 30 instructors (minimum of 5 ) is offered at your location.
